

## **Membership Policy – Hallwent Region Skating Clubs**

1. Skaters designating Dundas Figure Skating Club as their home club with Skate Canada shall register for an ice-time program at a level appropriate for current tests passed as described on our current brochure. (Active Membership)
2. All home club skaters who have purchased ice time must take at least 1 lesson per week from a coach listed on the Dundas Figure Skating Club roster.
3. Honorary members, Officials, PA's and other eligible persons serving on the Club Board of Directors, Regional Board, WO Board and/or Skate Canada Board of Directors may register with Skate Canada through Dundas Figure Skating Club without the requirement of purchasing ice time. Only the current Skate Canada fee plus insurance will be charged. The Board has the option of charging the fee or paying the fee from Club funds.
4. Those registering as competitive skaters with Skate Canada, who are training at another sanctioned Skate Canada Club or Skating School, may designate Dundas Figure Skating Club as their home club without the requirement of purchasing ice time at the discretion of the Board. Only the current Skate Canada fee plus insurance will be charged. (Individual Membership)
5. Those registered at a University or College in another location who choose to retain Dundas Figure Skating Club as their home club may do so without the requirement of purchasing ice time at the discretion of the Board. Only the current Skate Canada fee plus insurance will be charged. (Individual Membership)
6. Those skating on a synchronized team in another location who choose to retain Dundas Figure Skating Club as their home club may do so without the requirement of purchasing ice time at the discretion of the Board. Only the current Skate Canada fee plus insurance will be charged. (Individual Membership)
7. Skaters who have been Active Members of Dundas FSC for a minimum of five (5) years but are no longer able to commit to a full program may, at the discretion of the Board, register for Individual Membership with Dundas FSC as their home Club with the option of "guest skating" for a maximum of twice the stated maximum guest skates allowed per session. Only the current Skate Canada fees plus insurance will be charge upon registration. (Individual Membership)
