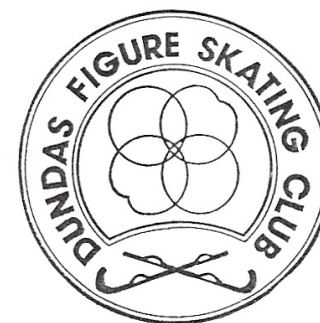

Test Date: Thursday, October 7

Junior:
2 days Juniors will skate on Intermediate Free and Dance session and must take instruction from a professional coach in addition to the group lesson.

Intermediate A: Any skater working on Skills.

Intermediate B: Any skater who has passed any one of Preliminary Skills, Free or Dance tests (all parts).

Senior: Any skater who has passed any two of Jr. Bronze Skills, Jr. Bronze Free Skate or Jr. Bronze Dance tests.

Adult:
1 day Any Skater 18 years of age or older. Adults must register for the sessions for which they qualify.

Special:
1 day Any Skater with a Home Club other than Dundas. Special Skaters must register for the session for which they qualify.
